

STEWART COUNTY ELECTION NOTICE **VOTER REGISTRATION**

The Stewart County Election Commission is open for voter registration for the State Primary (Republican and Democratic), County General Election to be held on **Thursday, August 4, 2022** in Stewart County, Tennessee

The **LAST DAY** before this election to register to vote is **Tuesday, July 5, 2022**.

Any Stewart County resident needing to register to vote, change their name or change their address may do so online at GoVoteTN.com. By mail applications must be postmarked by July 5, 2022. To register or update a registration in person, visit the Stewart County Election Commission Office.

If you attempted to register to vote at the Department of Safety, Department of Human Services, another state agency, or if you registered by mail but you **have not** received a voter registration card, you should contact the office immediately at 931-232-5100.

ABSENTEE VOTING BY-MAIL: A qualified voter may submit a request to vote by mail to the Election Commission Office from **May 6, 2022 – July 28, 2022**.

EARLY VOTING by personal appearance (no reason required), at the Election Commission Office will be **July 15 – 30, 2022**.

INACCESSIBLE POLLING PLACE - TCA 2-3-109 provides that if a polling place is inaccessible to any elderly voter or voter with a disability, those persons have the right to vote early or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. To vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, such voters must give written notice to: The Stewart County Election Commission, 110 Natcor Drive, PO Box 217, Dover, TN 37058, of their intention to do so no later than July 25, 2022.

State ID Law: A Federal or Tennessee state government issued photo ID is required to vote in person, unless an exception applies. This applies during early voting at the Election Commission Office and on Election Day at your assigned polling place
