The Stewart County Election Commission is open for voter registration for the Special Election for vacancy in U.S. House of Representatives, District No. 7 to be held on Tuesday, December 2, 2025 in Stewart County, Tennessee.

Notice is hereby given that the last day to register to vote is Monday, November 3, 2025 for the December 2, 2025 Election.

All persons who have moved their residence are required to change their registration records with this office. If you attempted to register to vote but you have not received a voter registration card, you should contact the office immediately at 931-232-5100.

EARLY VOTING by personal appearance (no reason required) at the Election Commission Office will be November 12 – November 26, 2025.

INACCESSIBLE POLLING PLACE -TCA 2-3-109 provides that if a polling place is inaccessible to any elderly voter or voter with a disability, those persons have the right to vote early or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. To vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, such voters must give written notice to: The Stewart County Election Commission, 110 Natcor Drive, P.O. Box 217, Dover, TN. 37058, of their intention to do so no later than November 25, 2025.

A Photo ID is now required to vote, unless an exception applies. This applies during early voting at the Election Commission Office and also on Election Day at your assigned polling place

WHAT PHOTO ID IS ACCEPTABLE?

- a. Tennessee driver's license with your photo
- b. United States Passport
- c. Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security photo ID
- d. Photo ID card issued by the federal government or State of Tennessee, such as an employee ID from the U.S. Department of Energy with your photo
- e. United States Military photo ID, including a Veteran Identification Card
- f. Tennessee handgun carry permit card with your photo

WHAT PHOTO ID IS NOT ACCEPTABLE?

- a. College student photo IDs
- b. Privately issued photo IDs, such as your discount club or bank card with your photo
- c. Photo IDs issued by other states or by county or city government, including library cards
